A Relatable Success Story

The job market is no easy place. Even with a college degree and an MBA, I found it difficult to find employment after spending so much time as a stay at home mom. It was then I decided that if I couldn't find the job I wanted, I would create one.

Spousal support would end, so I researched what I could do that wouldn't require more school or a large investment. Talking with my mom, she mentioned that she paid her cleaner \$30 an hour to clean her house each week. Realizing that I wouldn't mind making \$30 an hour, I decided to start my own cleaning business.

The first month I had six cleanings, and I noticed the clients were extremely grateful for my work. Not just getting a clean home, but grateful I could be trusted to help them care for their pets, and belongings. It turned out the care I gave *their home* made them feel cared for *as people* as well. That's when my "why" changed from simply making money, to feeling happy, fulfilled, useful, and valuable by helping clients in a fundamental way.

After 12 weeks my schedule was completely full and I couldn't take on anymore clients. I didn't like having to say no to new clients who would value my service, so I decided to hire an employee. I was nervous at first, but with a few minor lessons like navigating how to turn my clients over to the employee, it was a success. I'm still here in my 8th year building upon that early success with a growing crew and client base.

One thing I found about expanding and becoming an employer is that the reason why you're doing this needs to go beyond just making money. I like teaching and encouraging my employees to grow and be successful in their work and in their personal lives. I like the effect my business has on the lives of my employees and the framework it provides for them to live and support their families. I also like that I can set the bar for any future employers they'll have.

Employees want to be valued as people rather than just worker bees. The recent pandemic made many who had become fed up with their current employment rethink their value and worth. The great resignation over the past two years is a staggering sign that people expect more from their employer/employee relationship. It's not that people don't want to work, it's that people's expectations have changed and they are done being treated like line items. People want a company and a leader that they can trust and rely on, and we must strive to be worthy of that.

Coaching & Training

One-on-one coaching is extremely expensive and often not necessary for every person in every circumstance. To maximize the people that are helped and minimize costs, we have modeled this program after "group coaching". The weekly live training sessions on Wednesday evenings goes through the course curriculum. Then on Monday mornings, we will have general live Q&A sessions to answer questions about curriculum, offer strategy and inspiration for your business, and leadership help as well.

Quarterly deep dives will be a very intense day of learning, applying, getting new unique tools to help you grow, and creating your next 90-day action plan. It's a perfect mix of teaching + training + coaching that brings a well-rounded approach to your growing business.
